## Understanding your 2023 vision coverage



Your plan covers a routine eye exam each year. And eyewear, like glasses or contacts. Original Medicare doesn't usually cover these things. But we offer it as part of your Medicare Advantage plan.

## Learn more about your routine eye exam



A routine eye exam will help you find out if you need glasses or contacts. For us to cover this exam, you must see a provider in our medical network or the EyeMed® network.

## Learn more about your eyewear coverage



Your eyewear coverage is set up as a yearly allowance benefit. You need to visit an EyeMed provider to use your benefit. Your allowance benefit for eyewear should automatically apply when you visit an EyeMed provider. This means you won't need to pay up front. And you won't need to send us information to get paid back. If you choose eyewear that costs more than your benefit amount, you'll have to pay the difference.

### When you can use your allowance

You can only use your allowance for prescription eyewear, like glasses or contacts. If you choose eyewear that costs more than your benefit amount, you'll have to pay the difference.
